PARTIAL JUDGMENT AS TO **DEFENDANT NINGBO SUNNY ELECTRONIC CO. LTD** 

This is the Final Order pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54(b) entering partial judgment on the jury's verdict (Dkt. No. 501) (the "Verdict") in favor of Plaintiff Optronic Technologies, Inc. ("Orion") against Defendant Ningbo Sunny Electronic Co. Ltd. ("Defendant") as to Orion's claims for damages under Section 1 of the Sherman Act, Section 2 of the Sherman Act, Section 7 of the Clayton Act, and the California Cartwright Act, Cal. Bus. & Profs. Code § 16600, et seq. (collectively, the "Damages Claims").<sup>1</sup>

Judgment is entered on the Damages Claims in the amount of \$50,400,000 in accordance with the Verdict's award of \$16,800,000 in damages as trebled pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 15(a), with post-judgment interest thereon from the date of entry of judgment at the applicable federal postjudgment interest rate until paid in full. Orion is further awarded its costs of suit and reasonable
