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1 This Court, having considered Plaintiff Ex Parte Application for an Order Compelling 2 Celestron Acquisition, LLC to Produce Invoices and a Temporary Restraining Order, hereby orders 3 as follows:

1. Defendant Ningbo Sunny Electronic Co., Ltd. ("Defendant") and third-party 4 Celestron Acquisition LLC ("Celestron") are hereby enjoined from selling, divesting, 5 hypothecating, or transferring out of the United States any assets, product, or receivables in their 6 7 possession associated with telescopes manufactured by Ningbo Sunny and imported into the United 8 States through ViewWay Optics Enterprises Co., Ltd. ("ViewWay").

9 2. Within 10 days of the issuance of this Order, Defendant and Celestron shall produce 10 to Plaintiff all invoices, bills of lading, communications, and other documents relating to telescope sales to, telescope purchases from, or telescope imports by ViewWay created or sent between 11 January 1, 2020 to the present. 12

13 3. Plaintiff, Defendant, and Celestron are directed to appear before the Court on at 1:30 p.m. on July 15___, 2020 and to show cause as to why the temporary relief issued in this 14 Order should not continue as a preliminary injunction, and/or whether additional or other relief 15 should issue. 16

Defendant and Celestron may file a brief in response to this order to show 4. 17 case no later than Monday, July 13, 2020 by the close of the business day. 18 IT IS SO ORDERED.
